



Items for Staff to Bring to Camp

- ☐ Bible
- ☐ Sleeping Bag
- ☐ Bedding/Pillow
- ☐ Bath Towels/Wash Clothes
- ☐ Toiletry Items
- ☐ Shorts/pants (it gets warm/hot during the day, but cool at night)
- ☐ *Shirts (we issue two staff shirts the rest is on you)
- ☐ Raincoat/Poncho
- ☐ Sweaters/Sweatshirts
- ☐ Boots/Sturdy Shoes (you must have close-toed shoes for the Challenge Course, for hiking, and for working in many areas of camp. Please plan to bring a pair.)
- ☐ Under garments
- ☐ Bathing Suit (females: one piece or tankini please and males: no speedos)
- ☐ Musical Instrument (if you play one and would like to share your talents)
- ☐ Resource Books (just any resources you may want to bring)
- ☐ Camp Program Material (costumes and etc.)
- ☐ Devotional Books (for you or campers)
- ☐ Registration and Insurance (if you plan to park a car at Camp)
- ☐ Flashlight (optional)

Things you don't need to bring:

- ☐ Pets of any kind
- ☐ Cigarettes, Vaping materials
- ☐ Alcohol or Marijuana
- ☐ Illegal Drugs
- ☐ Suggestive or pornographic imagery (virtual or real)
- ☐ Firecrackers or fireworks of any kind
- ☐ Valuable electronics, jewelry or other belongings
- ☐ **Excessive cash (because you've got a ton of that laying around...)

*Please make sure the shirt and clothing you bring are free of any questionable material (alcohol, drug references, secular musicians or bands, innuendo, rude cartoons, and etc.).
